## 2020 Beau Melange

We have been blessed with a great location here in Creston and have been producing our flagship Bordeaux blend, Beau Melange since 2002. The most compelling wines are born in a specific vineyard and are the result of years of planning, tending to the vines and cultivating when perfectly ripe.

The 2022 growing season was a challenging one with unusually high temperatures for an extended time, some rain and later than normal harvest dates. Our mantra through it all was "patience" with our last pick on October 11th. We are very happy with the wines in barrel and look forward to nurturing this vintage through to bottling.

100% Estate fruit creates the 19th vintage of this stellar blend, the winery's flagship cuvée, combining 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Cabernet Franc, and 25% Merlot. Spending 23 months in 100% French oak, the mouthfeel is a paradigm of dusty tannins and cashmere carpet of plum and mocha. The remarkable muster of violets, cherry pie, and sweet earth is generous, vibrant, balanced and well structured. As always with this wine, patience is highly rewarded. Will peak in 2035. .
